DURATION OF THE PROJECT AND RENEWAL —

The project has a minimum duration of 90 days. Upon expiration, the multidisciplinary team of the facility will assess whether to conclude the Guest's program or request an extension from the Guest's relevant ASL.

The treatment, whether in a residential or semi-residential setting, is fully covered by the Regional Health Service.



ACCESS PROCEDURES ____

For residents in ASL RM5

The referral can be made by territorial facilities (Mental Health Center, General Practitioner, Specialized Centers, Hospitals) or by private specialists to the Nutrition and Eating Disorder Evaluation Unit (DNA) of ASL RM 5 - Casa della Salute in Palombara Sabina (RM) - Piazza S. D'Acquisto by calling the number 0774634458 (Email: uosd.dca@aslroma5.it).

After the initial evaluation interview conducted by the ASL RM 5 Evaluation Unit, a second meeting will follow with the Structure's Director or a specialist appointed by them.

For residents in other ASLs in Lazio and outside the Region

RECEPTION ____

The staff of the Reception Office, present on-site, welcomes the Guest and their family members. Each staff member, within their area of expertise, works to ensure the comfort of both the Guest and their family from the moment of admission to the time of discharge.

Upon admission, the Guest must present the following administrative documentation:

- Personal identification document
- Health card with regional code
- Documentation related to ticket exemption

INTENSIVE THERAPEUTIC-REHABILITATIVE RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

(20 beds in agreement with the Regional Health Service) Indicated in cases where intensive psycho-nutritional care and rehabilitation treatment is required, with temporary and specialized support in a daily living environment alternative to the usual one.

SEMI-RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

In day center (40 places in agreement with the Regional Health Service)

Organized 5 days a week for a total of 36 hours, indicated in cases where intensive psycho-nutritional care and rehabilitation treatment is required for patients who are in sufficient psycho-physical condition to travel and do not present family conflict situations that would make a complete removal from the pathological dynamics at home necessary.
